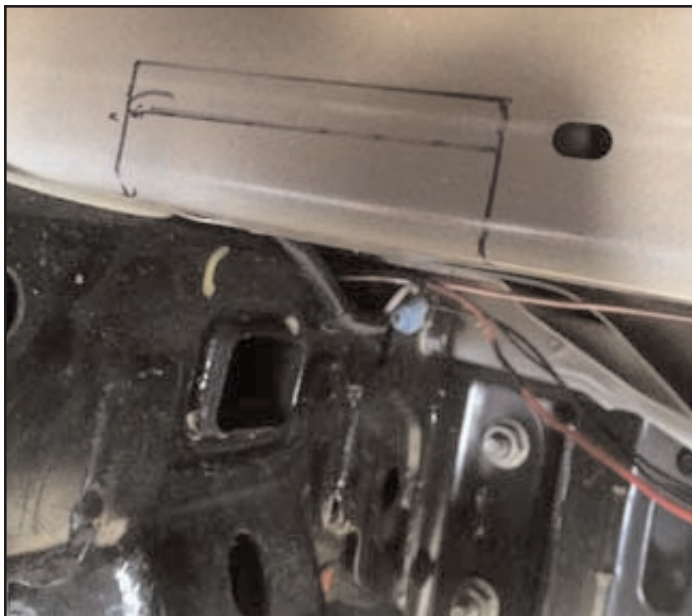


## SH3215-2 2015-16 Ford F150 Lowering Shackle

This product requires modification to the pickup. Before you proceed, make sure you want to do this modification. The part can be returned for a refund, if you decide not to proceed. This modification is nothing new. We have been doing this for many years and if you want to get the back of the pickup down a couple of inches, it's not hard and should only take a short period of time to accomplish.



Make sure your truck is sturdy, and on appropriate jack stands on a concrete surface.

Remove the stock shackles. It's important to locate your cut. Using the DJM shackle will help you find the location and how much material will need to be removed. As always, the more time spent on locating your cut the better it will come out.



Using a cut-off wheel does the trick and makes a nice cut. Make sure there is no contact with any other surfaces. It's not recommended to over tighten the red urethane bushing. It just needs to be snugged up (about 35 ft lbs). A little grease would not hurt. Use thread lock.
